- The curriculum has been modified for success in International Benchmarking Tests (TIMSS, PISA, ASSET) in view of the National Agenda of UAE.


Choices

- Introduced Home Science in Grades XI for all three streams










DPS Dubai Students' Achievement Compared to Their Peers in Private Schools of Dubai
